- DTN's Pewabic Project, in collaboration with the City of Iron Mountain, has been awarded a \$183,000 Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund grant.
 - DTN has already fundraised over \$35,000 in matching funds.
 - Project will add 5-miles of new professionally built multi-use non-motorized trails to the area.
 - This will total 11 miles of trails within walking distance of downtown Iron Mountain.

- Winter grooming at Fumee Lake Natural area and Marion Park in Norway, MI.
 - Our snowmobile grooming machines create classic cross-country glide tracks and multi-use corduroy snow surfaces, while the snowdog and Rokon machines create a 24" wide singletrack trails ideal for fatbiking.

How your Trail Partnership Helps DTN fulfill its mission

DTN is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that depends 100% on fundraising from memberships, events, donations, and partnerships to fulfill our mission.

Matching funds for grants: Most grants include a required matching component ranging from 20%-50% of the granted amount. For example, our Pewabic Project (6-miles of world-class professionally built trails) was awarded a \$183,000 Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund grant that requires \$64,000 in matching funds from our organization. Your support will help us provide matching funds for grants as we


continue to build world class trails around Dickinson County.

Tools/Machinery: Trail construction and maintenance is capital intensive work. We try to keep our volunteers equipped with the best trail tools on the market. There are also costs that go into maintaining the club's machinery including: Bobcat E20 Mini-excavator, three SnowDog singletrack groomers, three powerful snowmobiles XC ski groomers, and a ROKON snowbike. Looking to the future, there are other machines we would love to own but do not yet have the means to acquire, including a walk behind skid steer, which would allow us to build trails faster and to a higher standard.

New Trail Construction: DTN has a core group of dedicated and skilled volunteers who build trails each year. DTN also hires professional trail builders for projects that are beyond the scope of our volunteers. Our partners bring experience, expertise, and capital to our projects that assure the finished product is ready for riders, hikers, and runners, but will be sustainable and require less maintenance in the long run.

Education and youth programs: DTN is proud to team up with 906 Adventure Club for our area's youth adventure rides. Continuing this program and opening it up to more of the area youth will require further support from the community. DTN also sponsors and hosts mountain bike skills clinics like "For the Love of Bikes" who provide instruction for riders of all ages.

Events: Our local events like the Tour de Dickinson, Snotscycle, Ogee Challenge, and OC5K attract hundreds of participants. These events have operating costs for timing, shirts, food, drinks, etc. These events attract riders and runners from multiple states, stimulate our local economy, showcase our trails and provide an excellent platform to promote our partner's names and logos on social media, banners, newspaper, television news reports, participant bibs and race placards.
